The Adult Practical Nursing program at the Capital Region BOCES Career & Technical School, Albany campus, prepares a competent and effective graduate nurse to safely practice nursing within the scope of the Nurse Practice Act. Program graduates are prepared to take the National Council Licensure Examination and apply for state licensure as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).



PREADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Score of 25th percentile or above on pre-entrance exam (\$30 fee)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Successful interview
- High school diploma or GED
- Professional and personal references
- Physical exam and immunizations
- CPR certification

FULL-TIME PROGRAM:

- Length: Sept.-June (10 months)
- Hours: Monday-Friday 8 a.m.-2:30 p.m.

PART-TIME PROGRAM:

- Length: Nov.-June (18 months)
- Hours: 1st four months: Mon-Thurs 3-7 p.m. Next 14 mos.: Mon & Weds 3-7 p.m. and Thurs 3 p.m.-10:30 p.m. or Friday 8 a.m.-3:30 p.m.

- Application fee: \$25 (for candidates passing entrance exam)
- Commitment fee: \$100 upon acceptance (nonrefundable; credited toward tuition)
